Improvement Plan Update

Dayshare and Parent Portal: Staff are currently training to use the new parent nursery communication tool. We are planning to go live soon.

All the rooms are under construction; modifying each areas of learning. Come and see the **Jumping Roos** room as have just incorporated a **black and white**, baby focused play area, filled with sensory toys.

Jumping Roos: Are enjoying the story sacks using puppets to bring their favourite stories to life.

Little Wallabies: Have created a lovely 'seaside' in their role play area which has allowed the children to creatively express their imagination.

Little Explorers: Have been looking at the letter 's' in letters and sounds. The children enjoyed finding objects in the environment beginning with the sound 's'. Parent activity suggestion: - please see what you can find at home starting with the letter 's' with your child?
