



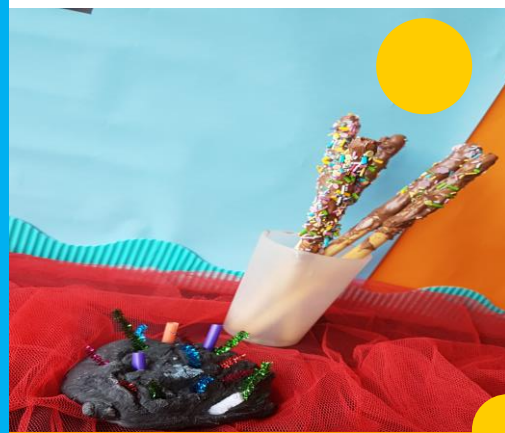
Little Roos Newsletter
